

This diagram is one path to assist you in your maturing with God. Like soccer skill development, we first start slow and simple because we do not want to be overwhelmed, and get frustrated and disappointed. As a coach, you understand that players learn skills best in a slow and simple environment. As they acquire the skills, you will place them into practices where speed and complexity come into play. Our maturing in God is a similar process of learning.

So, for example, we start reading the bible in small bites. We learn some basics of prayer, meditation, and worship. In this process, as we are prompted by the Holy Spirit, we confess those sins, forgive those who have hurt us, and surrender those aspects of our lives that need to die for Christ to reign more fully.

Growth and maturity is a process. We must cultivate rich soil so that God's seed may take hold and flourish. Even then, we must be patient because it takes time. There are tangible signs of growth as we change but the final component is the fruit (Mark 4:26-29). This process is seed, time and harvest must be experienced to reach maturity.

None of these practices are done because we should do them; they are done because God has placed a desire in our heart to draw nearer to Him. They are a grace-filled gift from God, not an obligation.

Then He said, "The kingdom of God is like a man who throws seed on the ground; and he goes to bed at night and gets up every day, and [in the meantime] the seed sprouts and grows; how [it does this], he does not know. The earth produces crops by itself; first the blade, then the head

[of grain], then the mature grain in the head. But when the crop ripens, he immediately puts in the sickle [to reap], because [the time for] the harvest has come."

Therefore, let us move beyond the elementary teachings about Christ and be taken forward to maturity, not laying again the foundation of repentance from acts that lead to death, and of faith in God
