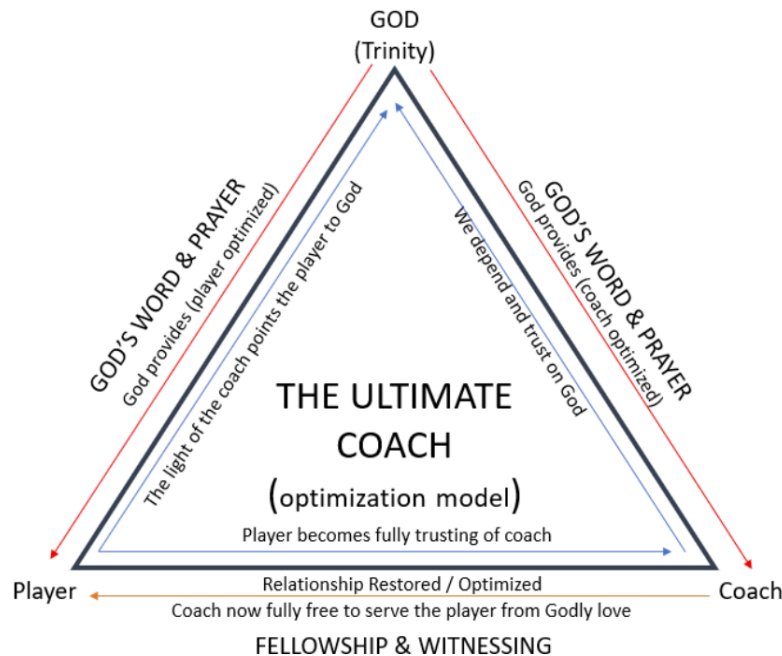




The Ultimate Coach-Triangle Revisited
